

EMILY J JOHNSON



Emily J. Johnson was born in Sep 1889 in Chalco Sarpy County NE. She died January 7, 1959 (aged 69) in Colorado, USA. She was buried in Crown Hill Cemetery, Wheat Ridge, Jefferson County, Colorado

Emily married William Speakman in 1910. Children from this marriage were: Lawrence (Laurence) Speakman Sharp born in 1911 in Nebraska. Lila Speakman was born after 1912. Emily next married Guy Corrick after 1920.

“Emily was the fourth child of John and Margaret Johnson. She was born in Sarpy Co. near Chalco Nebr. In Sept. 1889. Moved to Lyons Nebr the year 1894. Her father died in 1897. Mother had rheumatism, had a sale that fall, went to Hot Springs Colo. Emily stayed with her grandfather Curley at (*Sarpy County*) and went to school. Brothers and sisters were taken by friends and relatives until mother came back to Lyons to the farm 2 ½ miles n.w. (80A).

“Laura and Mary were married by then (*when they moved to the 80 in 1906*). Emily, Oliver, Archie and Bert were home. We lived there 2 years. Emily quit school while living there. She was in the eighth grade. We moved to the 160 joining it on the east. Mother died in August of the second year. Jim had bought a relinquished claim in Cheyenne Co. and had to go and live on it a while to hold it. Emily, Oliver, Archie, and our Uncle Jim Curley picked the corn.

“Bert went to Hobart Okla with Mary and Lee Senter to live. Jim came back in the winter of 1909 & 10. We had a sale. Emily worked for Gilbert Swanson after the sale then married Bill Speakman, then went to Dalton Nebr. Laura and Abe Sharp were out there then and Jim.

“Mother had paid off the \$4,000.00 on the 240 Acres and the sale netted each of us seven kids \$400.00 (*\$4000?*). Jim traded his homestead to Emily for her share in the 240 acres, and sold Bill the horses and (?) he had. The homestead was 160 acres east of Dalton. Laurance and Lila was born there. Bill couldn’t make a living for them so Laura and Abe took Lawrence afterwards and adopted him.

“Emily got a divorce from Bill and he went to S. Dak. near Yankton, to his folks. Emily married Guy Carrick (Corrick), lived a couple years with him, then divorced him. Run a Dew-Drop-Inn in Ogden Utah, then moved to Denver.”
