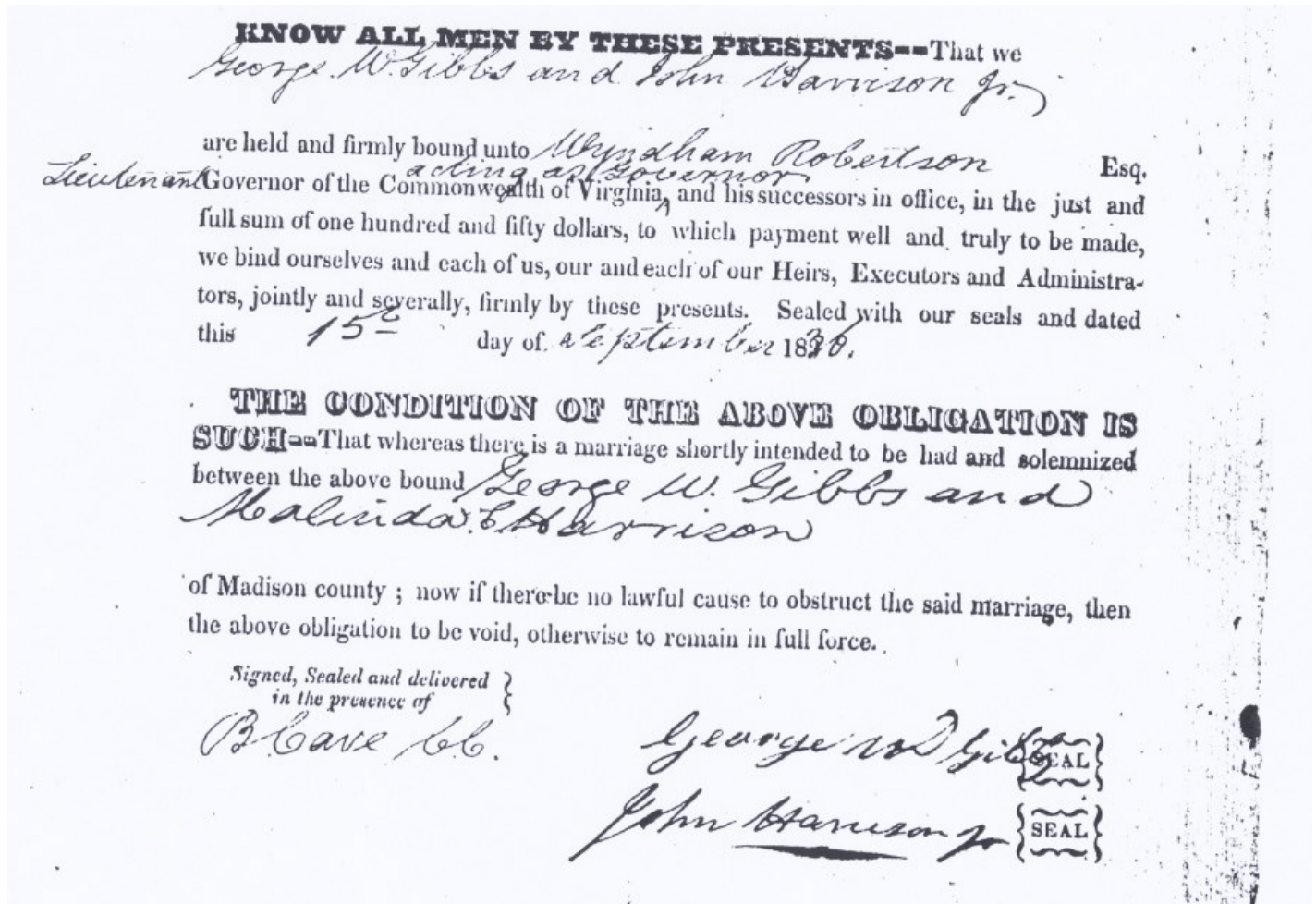
George married **Malinda Crisler Harrison** on 22 Sep 1836 in Madison Co Va.
